1. Introduction

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and is considered a serious offense. This policy outlines the college's stance on ragging and the measures in place to prevent and address such incidents.

2. Definition of Ragging

Ragging is defined as any act that violates the dignity and respect of an individual. This includes physical or mental harassment, bullying, intimidation, or any form of abuse that causes distress or harm to another student. Ragging can be verbal, physical, emotional, or sexual in nature.
